Food Policy

Food Trucks

Food trucks will be charged the following rates:

\$150 + HST per day

OR

\$400 + HST for three days, with a \$200 refund upon fulfillment of contract

All food trucks must apply for a food truck permit with the Township of North Huron and pay the associated fee. The Township of North Huron's definition of a food truck includes any vehicle (whether propelled by a motor or by the application of force by a person or animal, both mobile and immobile) which is used for the storage or preparation of food or drink intended for immediate consumption by the public (both prepared on premises and pre-packaged), and that has the ability to vend food and beverage stuffs and sundry items from more than one location in any given day.

All food trucks will be provided with a maximum of 2 day passes per food truck per day. Food trucks are responsible for paying any additional admission fees for all their employees entering the grounds each day.

Snack Vendors

Snack vendors will be charged the following rates:

\$75 + HST per day

OR

\$150 + HST for three days, with a \$50 refund upon fulfillment of contract

Snack vendors may include non-alcoholic beverages, chips, candy, ice cream, cotton candy, baked goods, etc.

Snack vendors are responsible for their and any employee's admission fees to the show grounds each day. This may consist of paying the daily gate admission or purchasing an HPTHA membership & wristband.

- preference will be given to not for-profit groups
- Not-for-profit food vendors must donate 10% of their net income earned during the show to the Huron Pioneer Threshers & Hobby Association Inc.
- all vendors must provide a paper copy of proof of liability insurance at a minimum of \$2,000,000
- each vendor will complete and submit a Special Event Food Vendor Application to Huron Perth Public Health within the required time frame (the link to the HPPH form will be provided to vendors)
- payment by e-transfer is preferred and should be sent to accounts@hptha.com
- youth groups such as 4-H, Junior Farmers, Cadets, Boy Scouts, Girl Guides, etc. may, at the discretion of the Board, have their fees discounted or waived
- we will strive for standardized pricing among food vendors to ensure all vendors can remain competitive
- The HPTHA Board reserves the right to approve or deny any food vendor
- No refunds will be issued after June 1st
